5. Receive an update from the Office of Emergency Services.
6. Approve and adopt a Joint Resolution of the Del Norte County Board of Supervisors and the City Council of Crescent City replacing DNCO Resolution 2008-023 and the City of Crescent City Resolution 2008-019 Establishing a Joint American with Disabilities Act (ADA) Advisory Commission as requested by the Chair of the ADA Commission and receive an update from the Chair regarding the ADA Commission's progress.
