Memorial Bench Program

Background:

- The intent of this Memorial Bench Program is to provide citizens with an opportunity to commemorate the lives of their family or friends.
- To preserve continuity through Crescent City, memorial benches are ordered from one company, by City staff. Plaques mounted on the benches are designed and paid for by the applicant. Plaque design must be approved by staff before bench installation.
- Memorial benches will be positioned to maximize the benefit to an area. Memorial bench placement will only be allowed at sites approved by City staff.
- The City reserves the right to move and/or remove any memorial bench at any time.
- Memorial benches in an outdoor setting have an approximate lifespan of 10 years, or as determined by the Public Works Director. The City will provide for normal maintenance of the bench during its useful life. The City is not responsible for vandalism or damage caused by third parties. If the damage is so severe to cause removal of the bench, the City is not responsible for bench replacement.
- Requests under this program will processed as staff time and resources are available.
- This program does not create any right to place a bench

Memorial Bench Approval Process:

- Memorial bench requests will be processed in the order received. City staff will review the
 Memorial Bench application (with fees paid in full) and plaque design prior to submitting to the
 Director of Public Works and, finally, the City Manager for final approval. The Director of Public
 Works and the City Manager must approve of the bench location and plaque design before
 installation.
- The cost for the memorial bench is determined by the actual cost of materials (bench, concrete pad, etc) and the actual time of the City staff. The cost to the applicant includes the bench procurement, installation of the bench, and plaque. If City Staff determines the location of the bench requires a concrete foundation pad additional fees may be assessed before installation.

Placement Process:

Once approved, the bench will be ordered by City Staff. After the bench is received, if
necessary, the City will pour the concrete pad (weather contingent) and then place the
Memorial Bench. The applicant will be notified, in advance if possible, as to when the bench will
be installed.
