

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-51

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRESCENT CITY
APPROVING THE STORM DRAIN MASTER PLAN PREPARED BY GHD INC.**

WHEREAS, the City applied for and received Community Development Block Grant funding for the development of a Storm Drain Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, following a publicly advertised Request for Proposals (RFP), the City selected GHD Inc. to perform the Storm Drain Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Storm Drain Master Plan is to evaluate the performance of the existing storm drain system under current and future conditions, identify locations and causes of flooding, and develop a prioritized Capital Improvement Program (CIP) that supports the phasing and sequencing of capital planning and implementation; and

WHEREAS, the overall objective of the Storm Drain Master Plan is to support investment decisions that reduce flood risk and improve storm drain system reliability; and

WHEREAS, having an approved Storm Drain Master Plan is key to obtaining future grants to make the improvements contained within the Plan's Capital Improvement Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Crescent City, State of California that:

1. The Storm Drain Master Plan dated May 7, 2026 prepared by GHD Inc. is hereby approved.
2. Staff are directed to submit the Storm Drain Master Plan to the granting agency in compliance with grant requirements.
